Hosting Speaking Contests

Creed Speaking, Prepared Speaking, Extemporaneous Speaking, Discussion Meet, Job Interview, Quiz Bowl, Parliamentary Procedure

- Local Contests: Local contests should be held in a time frame in order to prepare students for the district competition.
- District Contests: District contests should be held between January 15 and February 15. All FFA chapters are expected to host a district contest when it becomes their turn in alphabetical rotation. If, for any reason, you feel that your chapter cannot host when it is your turn, you may request to the State FFA Executive Director and Board of Officers to be skipped in the rotation.
- The underscored chapter in each district is the host school and in charge of the district contest. The contest may be held at an alternate location if mutually agreed upon by the chapters in that district, but the underscored chapter is still in charge of the contest. The State FFA Association will provide awards for district winners as well as topics, questions, abilities, items of business, score sheet masters and contest rules and procedures. All other responsibilities for the contest are up to the chapter designated as "in charge" of the contest for that particular year.
- Sectional Contests: Will be held the second or third week of March and are scheduled by the State FFA Office in cooperation with the chapters of the 10 State Officers representing their sections. The State FFA Association will provide awards for sectional winners as well as topics, questions, abilities, items of business, score sheet masters and contest rules and procedures. All other responsibilities for the contest are up to the chapter of the State Officer in each section.
- State Contests: Will be held in June as part of the events of the State FFA Convention. All coordination of the contest will be handled by the State FFA Association and will be conducted by the State FFA officers and their advisors.
