

## 2013-14 Largest Percentage of School Population Membership Award Application

This award has been developed to recognize chapters who have the largest percentage of their school population involved in the FFA Organization. The State FFA Officers realize that some schools have increased their FFA membership to the point that most of their school population may be involved as members in the FFA Organization.

Only chapters that complete this application are eligible for this award. From the applications submitted, the top three with the largest percentage of their school population involved as members of the FFA Organization will be selected. Those three chapters selected will be recognized at the 4<sup>th</sup> General Session on Wednesday morning at the State FFA Convention in Madison.

Largest percentage of FFA membership compared to the school population is calculated by defining the school population as the number of students that have the ability to join FFA in grades 7-12 or grades 9-12 depending on whether the school allows for a middle school agricultural education program and FFA involvement. FFA membership for this award **will not include** the FFA members who are high school graduates.
