### **SESSION 1:**

#### **Jr. High Essay Contest:**

The four state finalists need to be present for the awards presentation at the State FFA Convention in the Exhibition Hall - Hall D at the Alliant Energy Center in Madison Tuesday, June 11 during the First Session. The session begins at 12:00 p.m. and we ask that the participants be in their "special seating" in Hall D by 11:45 a.m.

Only the Proficiency State Finalists (up to five in each area) will be recognized on stage at the State FFA Convention on Tuesday, June 11 during the Second Session (3:00pm). Recipients need to be present at the convention session to receive their proficiency awards. If you have a gold rated applicant, they will still receive a cash award that can be picked up at the FFA Foundation Thank You Station once the student has written their thank you letter. All gold recipients however will not go on stage during Session 2. Only the State Finalists.

Proficiency State Finalists only receive sponsored tickets to the Sponsors and Award Winners Dinner held on Tuesday evening. Teachers of meal ticket recipients have been notified. Names are also posted online. Advisors must request the sponsored tickets on the ticket order form.
