You will need to have a 200-word essay on how your artwork promotes the agricultural industry> This essay is part of the rubric for your artwork at the WI FFA Convention. There will be no face to face judging.

2-Dimensional: These are projects that highlight some part of the agricultural industry by adding some kind of 2-D medium. 2D art may include paintings, drawings, prints and photographs.\*Note: Nothing but paint or 2-D art medium is added to the original project.

3-Dimensional: Projects could include: welding horseshoes into a sculpture, adding ears, a tail and nose to a mailbox so it looks like a pig or carving a block of cheese or wood stump of into a falcon, or a taxidermy project. You could also do a collage of the FFA emblem using various small grains.
