PROFICIENCY

DESCRIPTIONS: *FOOD SERVICE: Wisconsin Only*

Involves students working for wages and/or experience in the areas of food preparation and/or food service as well as management of food distribution systems. Work experience could be obtained at restaurants, fast-food facilities, delicatessens, grocery stores, and other establishments that prepare and serve prepared food to customers or prepare food and food related items for sale. This area does not include enterprises that are recognized in the Ag Processing or Food Science proficiency areas. Nor does it relate to activities that are not directly related to food preparation or directly related to the serving of prepared food. (Note: Examples of activities not recognized are serving as a host or hostess or activities limited to cashier duties.)

Organic Agriculture: Wisconsin Only

Includes programs in which a student uses best management practices in producing food and/or agricultural products following industry guidelines for organic agriculture. Minimum Standard: Applicants must use the extra page of the proficiency to verify the organic status of the operation.
