

# Wisconsin FFA Chapter Website Competition

## Objective

The FFA Website Competition is designed to recognize chapters that promote their chapters through their own website.

## Rules and Regulations

**Eligibility:** All active chapters within Wisconsin in good standing are eligible for competition. Entry forms for the competition must be submitted to the Wisconsin FFA Center postmarked no later than November 1. Any forms that are received after that date are will not be eligible for the competition.

## **Regulations:**

1. This is a state level competition.
2. As part of the on-line RLC registration process, the website URL address must be officially registered no later than November 1<sup>st</sup>.
3. The topic focus of the web site should be the FFA Chapter.
4. The website must be available for viewing on the Internet after November 1<sup>st</sup>.
5. Student members, not advisors, must prepare the website. Advisors should serve as consultants to ensure that the website is well organized, contain substantiated statements, and are presented in a professional manner. The website must be created by the students.
6. The website should be updated bimonthly.
7. Any photographs, text, trademarks, or names that are used on the site must be supported by proper documentation and approvals indicated on the website. Members are expected to follow all applicable copyright laws and may be disqualified if items are used inappropriately.
8. The websites must include: the chapter's Program of Activates, link to wisconsinffa.org, link to ffa.org, link to their school website if applicable, photographs, acknowledgement of awards and accomplishments the chapter and chapter members have received at least within the last two years, list of the current officer team, a thank you message to the chapter's supporters, and chapter contact information.
9. Websites should be designed to allow for viewing by as many different platforms as possible. For example, comparable browsers would be: Netscape Navigator or Microsoft Internet Explorer.
10. Websites not adhering to these regulations will be disqualified.

## **Evaluations/Judging**

The judging will be done on a periodical basis after November 1<sup>st</sup>.

The judge must visit the site at least three times before State Convention in June.

## **Awards and Recognition**

At the FFA State Convention, chapters will be awarded ribbons based on judges' scores. The blue ribbon websites will be considered for further recognition. The first place and runner up chapters will receive plaques. There may be cash awards available depending upon the securing of sponsorship.
