Category	Points Possible	Description
Application complete	5	Applications completely and accurately filled out. Directions followed, i.e. use available space, information entered checked or spelling, all required signatures in place.
Leadership Activity in FFA	15	Officer and/or committee chair and committee assignments, event organizer, other local FFA chapter leadership responsibilities.
Participation in FFA and Alumni Activities	15	Emphasize personal and leadership development activities, such as speaking and other CDEs, FFA leadership conference participation (Sectional Leadership Conference, Half-Time, etc.) <u>and</u> participation in or assistance with local, state, national FFA Alumni activities.
FFA Achievements	20	Emphasize degrees earned, awards and recognition related to personal and leadership development, i.e. Star awards, proficiency awards, speaking and other CDE awards in local, state, national FFA.
Activity, accomplishments, recognition other than FFA	15	Activities, leadership, and accomplishments outside of FFA i.e. academics, extra/co-curricular in school, 4-H and other community, church, commodity/breed association, fair/show exhibition, and other activities.
Benefits of participation in WLC essay	30	Describe how applicant expects participation in WLC to benefit themselves and their chapter, school, and community—outline specific personal and group goals they plan to work on that will use what they hope to learn at WLC. Be specific.

In the real world and for this application spelling counts. Compose each section of the application in a word processor and spell check it before copying and pasting into the application. Spell check catches most spelling errors but not all (example: there, their, they're). Have someone proof read your completed application before sending it.
